COMPRISING

HHYC MONSOON WINTER SERIES 2018 AND HHYC MONSOON SPRING SERIES 2019 AND RHKYC MONSOON SPRING CUP 2019

Following the very successful inaugural Monsoon Series, Hebe Haven Yacht Club (HHYC) and the Big Boat Committee of the Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club (RHKYC) have again combined to bring you the Monsoon Series 2018-2019. Results from the HHYC Monsoon Winter Series 2018 and the Monsoon Spring Series 2019. Will be combined with results from races in the RHKYC Monsoon Spring Cup 2019, will be used for the Monsoon Series 2018-19. Boats are invited to join the racing in and around the neighbouring islands of Port Shelter.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Monsoon Series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and this Notice of Race (NoR).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Monsoon Series is open to big boats of the IRC and HKPN classes.
- 2.2 All boats that sail in any or all of the races of the series comprising the Monsoon Series shall be automatically entered into the Monsoon Series.
- 2.3 There is no formal entry procedure and no entry fee for the Monsoon Series other than the fees for the individual events detailed in item 3 of this NoR.

3. NOTICES OF RACE AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Separate NoRs and Sailing Instructions will be published for the HHYC Monsoon Winter Series 2018, the HHYC Monsoon Spring Series 2019 and the RHKYC Monsoon Spring Cup 2019.

4. VENUE

The races comprising the Monsoon Series will be held in the waters in and around Port Shelter.

5. SCORING

5.1 Scoring for the Monsoon Series will use the Cox-Sprague system detailed in Annex A.

5.2 Each race sailed will earn points towards the Monsoon Series.

6 PRIZES

6.1 Prizes will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed boat in both the IRC and HKPN Classes. A prize will also be awarded to the 1st placed IRC boat, dual scored under HKPN.

6.2 The prize-giving will be held at HHYC after the last race of the HHYC Monsoon Spring Series has been sailed.

The Cox-Sprague scoring system awards points dependent on the number of entries in a division. For example, in a division with 6 boats the winning boat receives 60 points and the second placed boat, 54 points, etc.

Points indicated in parenthesis () indicate the score to be awarded to any yacht which did not start (DNC), started on course side (OCS) retired (RET) did not finish (DNF) or was disqualified (DSQ).

If IRC or HKPN divisions are split into rating or handicap bands, the number of boats in each division will be used to determine a boats points in any race.
